Please refer to these notes in order to ensure the form is completed correctly.

- 1. All entries **must** be received by the closing date: **3rd February 2024**. We suggest you keep a photocopy of the completed form for future reference.
- 2. All entries must be sent to DPAF Entries, 37 Pinwood Meadow Drive, EXETER, EX4 9LA
- 3. One or several entries may be included on one form, as long as they are all submitted by the same person. Please use a further form (photocopied if necessary) if you do not have room for all entries on one form.
- 4. The **Competitor** is the person or group who will compete. The **Person Submitting** the entry may be the competitor, or may be their parent, teacher, school etc. Please include this information in the space provided.
- 5. Competitor Name is the name of the person or group taking part, eg *John Smith*, *Jean Jones & Betty Brown*, or *Nutwood Viol Consort*.
- 6. Competitor Age and Date of Birth are required if 18 or under. The qualifying age is that on 1st September 2023.
- 7. **Class Number** is essential. **Class Name** is used as an error check so please be sure to include it. Also include the instrument to be played where relevant, ie Woodwind, String or Brass Solo Classes.
- 8. **Competitor Phone Number** is essential in case they need to be contacted. If necessary this can be the group leader's number, but it is essential that contact can be made quickly and easily if necessary.

- 9. Competitor E-mail address is useful if available.
- 10. Please check the **Class Fee** carefully and enter it. Mistakes will delay processing.
- 11. Please use the **Further Information** for anything that may not fit elsewhere, eg if the competitor can only be available on certain days. We will try to accommodate such requests, **but cannot guarantee this.**
- 12. **Person submitting entry:** Please include all details indicated. It is important that we can contact you (preferably by phone) in the event of any doubts or problems with the form.
